Instructions for Parents/Guardians:

- This is a flexible 30-day plan. Feel free to adjust the activities based on your child's interests and pace.
- Keep the activities short, fun, and interactive.
- Encourage your child and celebrate their efforts!
- This is about exploration and enjoyment, not formal testing.

Day 1: English - Recognizing Letter A

- Show your child the letter 'A' (both capital and small).
- Say the sound of 'A' (as in apple).
- Find something at home that starts with 'A' (e.g., apple).

Day 2: Math - Counting 1

- Show your child one object (e.g., one toy, one finger).
- Say the number "one".
- Draw one simple shape (like a circle).

Day 3: Hindi - Recognizing Letter अ (Aa)

- Show your child the letter 'अ'.
- Say the sound of 'अ'.
- Point to a picture of something that starts with 'अ' (e.g., अनार - pomegranate).

Day 4: EVS - My Body - Head

- Talk about our head.
- Point to your child's head and your own.
- Draw a simple circle for a head.

Day 5: Craft - Handprint Fun

- Make a handprint with paint on paper.
- Talk about how many fingers you have on one hand (five).

Day 6: English - Recognizing Letter B

- Show your child the letter 'B' (both capital and small).
- Say the sound of 'B' (as in ball).
- Find something at home that starts with 'B' (e.g., ball).

Day 7: Math - Counting 2

- Show your child two objects.
- Say the number "two".
- Draw two simple shapes.

Day 8: Hindi - Recognizing Letter अ (Aa)

- Show your child the letter 'अ'.
- Say the sound of 'अ'.
- Point to a picture of something that starts with 'अ' (e.g., आम - mango).

Day 9: EVS - My Body - Eyes

- Talk about our eyes and what we do with them (see).
- Play a game of "I Spy" using your eyes.

Day 10: Craft - Finger Painting Fun

- Let your child make dots and lines with their fingers and different colors of paint.

Day 11: English - Matching A and a

- Show capital 'A' and small 'a' separately.
- Help your child match the capital letter to the small letter.

Day 12: Math - Counting 1 and 2 Review

- Show a group of 1 or 2 objects and ask your child to count them.

Day 13: Hindi - Matching अ and अ, आ and आ

- Show different forms of the letter 'अ' and 'आ'.
- Help your child match the similar letters.

Day 14: EVS - My Family

- Talk about who is in your family (mother, father, etc.).
- Look at family photos.

Day 15: Craft - Paper Tearing Fun

- Let your child tear colored paper into small pieces.

Day 16: English - Tracing Letter A

- Help your child trace the letter 'A' (both capital and small) on paper or in a sand tray.

Day 17: Math - Shape - Circle

- Show your child a circle.
- Find round objects at home (e.g., plate, ball).

Day 18: Hindi - Tracing Letter अ

- Help your child trace the letter 'अ' on paper or in a sand tray.

Day 19: EVS - My Body - Nose

- Talk about our nose and what we do with it (smell).
- Smell different things around the house (e.g., flower, food).

Day 20: Craft - Gluing Paper Pieces

- Let your child glue the torn paper pieces onto another sheet of paper to make a design.

Day 21: English - Color Recognition - Red

- Show your child the color red.
- Find red objects around the house.

Day 22: Math - Counting 3

- Show your child three objects.
- Say the number "three".

Day 23: Hindi - Recognizing Letter इ (i)

- Show your child the letter 'इ'.
- Say the sound of 'इ'.
- Point to a picture of something that starts with 'इ' (e.g., इमली - tamarind).

Day 24: EVS - My Body - Mouth

- Talk about our mouth and what we do with it (eat, talk).
- Make different faces using your mouth (smile, frown).

Day 25: Craft - Making a Simple Mask

- Use a paper plate or cardboard to make a simple mask shape.

Day 26: English - Recognizing Letter C

- Show your child the letter 'C' (both capital and small).
- Say the sound of 'C' (as in cat).

Day 27: Math - Shape - Square

- Show your child a square.
- Find square-shaped objects at home (e.g., a block).

Day 28: Hindi - Tracing Letter अ

- Help your child trace the letter 'अ' on paper or in a sand tray.

Day 29: EVS - My Body - Hands

- Talk about our hands and what we do with them (hold, clap).
- Play a clapping game.

Day 30: Craft - Decorating the Mask

- Let your child decorate the mask they made with colors, stickers, or other materials.

Bonus Activities (Do anytime!):

- Sing alphabet songs in English and Hindi.
- Read simple picture books together.
- Count objects during playtime.
- Talk about the weather each day.
- Draw your favorite things.
