Instructions for Parents/Guardians:

- This is a flexible 30-day plan. Adjust the activities based on your child's interests and pace.
- Keep the activities short, fun, and interactive.
- Encourage your child and celebrate their efforts!
- This is about reinforcing learning and exploration, not formal testing.

Day 1: English - Recognizing Letters C and D

- Show your child the letters 'C' and 'D' (both capital and small).
- Find objects at home that start with the letters 'C' and 'D' (e.g., cat, dog).
- Draw a picture of a cat or a dog.

Day 2: Math - Counting 1 to 5

- Count objects from 1 to 5.
- Write the numbers 1 to 5 in a notebook (with help).
- Draw groups of objects representing the numbers 1 to 5.

Day 3: Hindi - Recognizing Letters इ (i) and ई (ee)

- Show your child the letters 'इ' and 'ई'.
- Say words that start with 'इ' and 'ई' (e.g., इमली, ईख).
- Color a picture related to one of these words.

Day 4: EVS - My Body - Ears

- Talk about our ears and what we do with them (hear).
- Listen to different sounds around the house.
- Draw a picture of an ear.

Day 5: Craft - Paper Plate Animals

- Use paper plates to create simple animal faces (e.g., cat, dog, rabbit).
- Decorate them with colors and other materials.

Day 6: English - Recognizing Letters E and F

- Show your child the letters 'E' and 'F' (both capital and small).
- Find objects at home that start with the letters 'E' and 'F' (e.g., elephant, fish).
- Draw a picture of an elephant or a fish.

Day 7: Math - Shape - Triangle

- Show your child a triangle.
- Find triangle-shaped objects at home (e.g., a slice of pizza).
- Draw a triangle.

Day 8: Hindi - Recognizing Letters उ (u) and ऊ (oo)

- Show your child the letters 'उ' and 'ऊ'.
- Say words that start with 'उ' and 'ऊ' (e.g., उल्लू, ऊन).
- Color a picture related to one of these words.

Day 9: EVS - My Body - Legs

- Talk about our legs and what we do with them (walk, run).
- Do some simple leg exercises.
- Draw a picture of legs.

Day 10: Craft - Nature Collage

- Collect small natural items like leaves, twigs, and flowers.
- Glue them onto paper to create a nature collage.

Day 11: English - Matching C and c, D and d, E and e, F and f

- Show capital and small letters separately.
- Help your child match the capital letter to the small letter.

Day 12: Math - Counting 1 to 5 Review

- Count a mixed group of 1 to 5 objects.
- Write the numbers 1 to 5 in order.

Day 13: Hindi - Matching इ and इ, ई and ई, उ and उ, ऊ and ऊ

- Show different forms of the letters.
- Help your child match the similar letters.

Day 14: EVS - My Family

- Talk about the different roles of family members.
- Draw a family tree (simple version).

Day 15: Craft - Fingerprint Art

- Create pictures using only your fingerprints and different colors of paint.

Day 16: English - Tracing Letters C, D, E, F

- Help your child trace the letters 'C', 'c', 'D', 'd', 'E', 'e', 'F', and 'f'.

Day 17: Math - Shape - Rectangle

- Show your child a rectangle.
- Find rectangle-shaped objects at home.
- Draw a rectangle.

Day 18: Hindi - Tracing Letters इ, ई, उ, ऊ

- Help your child trace the letters 'इ', 'ई', 'उ', and 'ऊ'.

Day 19: EVS - My School

- Talk about the different parts of your school.
- Draw a picture of your school.

Day 20: Craft - Paper Tearing and Pasting - Shapes

- Tear colored paper into small pieces.
- Paste them onto paper to create different shapes (circle, square, triangle, rectangle).

Day 21: English - Color Recognition - Blue

- Show your child the color blue.
- Find blue objects around the house.
- Color a picture blue.

Day 22: Math - Counting 6 to 10

- Count objects from 6 to 10.
- Write the numbers 6 to 10 (with help).

Day 23: Hindi - Recognizing Letters र (ri) and ए (e)

- Show your child the letters 'र' and 'ए'.
- Say words that start with 'र' and 'ए'.
- Draw a picture related to one of these words (if possible).

Day 24: EVS - Animals Around Us

- Talk about different animals and their sounds.
- Draw your favorite animal.

Day 25: Craft - Making a Mask

- Use paper plates or cardboard to create a mask of an animal.
- Decorate it with colors and other materials.

Day 26: English - Simple Sentences (using pictures)

- Show pictures of simple actions (e.g., a boy eating, a girl reading).
- Help your child say a simple sentence for each picture (e.g., "The boy is eating.").

Day 27: Math - Comparing - Big and Small

- Show two objects, one big and one small.
- Ask your child to identify the big and small one.
- Draw a big circle and a small circle.

Day 28: Hindi - Recognizing Letters ऐ (ai) and ओ (o)

- Show your child the letters 'ऐ' and 'ओ'.
- Say words that start with 'ऐ' and 'ओ'.

Day 29: EVS - Plants Around Us

- Talk about different types of plants (trees, flowers).
- Draw a simple flower.

Day 30: Craft - Making a Puppet

- Use a paper bag or sock to create a simple puppet.
- Decorate it and put on a little puppet show.

Bonus Activities (Do anytime!):

- Sing alphabet songs in English and Hindi.
- Read simple picture books.
- Count objects during playtime.
- Talk about the weather each day.
- Draw your favorite things.
- Play simple board games.
- Help with simple tasks around the house.
