Day 1: English - Nouns

- List five naming words (nouns) you see in your living room.
- Draw a picture of your favorite animal and write its name.

Day 2: Math - Number Names (1-20)

- Write the number names for numbers 1 to 10.
- Write the number names for any five numbers between 11 and 20.

Day 3: Hindi - बारहखड़ी (ka, kha, ga...) - Part 1

- Write the बारहखड़ी for the letter 'क' (क, का, कि, की, कु, कू, के, कै, को, कौ, कं, कः).
- Say each sound aloud.

Day 4: EVS - My Family and Their Roles

- Write the names of your family members and one thing they do for the family. (e.g., Father - Goes to work).

Day 5: Computer - Parts of a Computer and Their Uses

- Match the computer part with its use:
- Monitor - () To type letters and numbers
- Keyboard - () Shows pictures and words
- Mouse - () Helps to point and click
- CPU - () The brain of the computer

Day 6: Craft - Making Animal Masks

- Use paper plates or cardboard to create a simple mask of your favorite animal in scrapbook.

Day 7: English - Verbs (Action Words)

- List five action words you do every day (e.g., eat, play, read).
- Write a simple sentence using one of these action words.

Day 8: Math - Addition (up to 20)

- Solve these addition problems:
 - $12 + 5 = ?$
 - $8 + 9 = ?$
 - $15 + 3 = ?$

Day 9: Hindi - बारहखड़ी (ka, kha, ga...) - Part 2

- Write the बारहखड़ी for the letter 'च' (च, चा, चि, ची, चु, चू, चे, चै, चो, चौ, चं, चः).
- Say each sound aloud.

Day 10: EVS - Our Helpers

- Name three people who help us in our community (e.g., teacher, doctor, and postman).
- Draw a picture of one of them in Scrapbook.

Day 11: Computer - Using the Mouse

- With a grown-up, practice left-clicking and double-clicking using a simple drawing program or game.

Day 12: Craft - Paper Tearing and Pasting

- Tear colored paper into small pieces and paste them to create a picture in Scrap book.

Day 13: English - Adjectives (Describing Words)

- List three describing words for a sunny day.
- Write a sentence using one of these describing words.

Day 14: Math - Subtraction (within 20)

- Solve these subtraction problems:
 - $18 - 6 = ?$
 - $11 - 4 = ?$
 - $15 - 9 = ?$

Day 15: Hindi - शब्द रचना (Making Words) - Part 1

- Make two simple words using the letters: क, म, ल. (e.g., कमल, कलम).

Day 16: EVS - Plants Around Us - Types of Plants

- Name Five types of trees and Five types of flowers you have seen.

Day 17: Computer - Introduction to the Keyboard Keys

- Identify the number keys (0-9) and the spacebar on the keyboard. Practice typing your name (if you know how) or a simple word.

Day 18: Craft - Vegetable Printing

- Use cut vegetables (like potato, ladyfinger) dipped in paint to create patterns on paper. (Adult supervision needed).

Day 19: English - Simple Sentences

- Write three simple sentences about things you like to do in summer.

Day 20: Math - Shapes around Us

- Find three objects at home that are round (circle-shaped) and three objects that are square or rectangular. Write their names.

Day 21: Hindi - शब्द रचना (Making Words) - Part 2

- Make two simple words using the letters: घर, चल. (e.g., घर, चल).

Day 22: EVS - Animals Around Us - Homes of Animals

- Match the animal to its home:
 - Dog - () Hive
 - Bird - () Kennel
 - Bee - () Nest

Day 23: Computer - Using the Backspace and Enter Keys

- With a grown-up, practice typing a short word, using the backspace to correct mistakes, and pressing the enter key to go to the next line (in a simple text editor if available).

Day 24: Craft - Thread Painting

- Dip a piece of thread in paint, place it on a folded piece of paper, close the paper, and gently pull the thread out to create interesting designs in Scrapbook.

Day 25: English - Opposites

- Match the following words with their opposites:
- Big - () Small
- Happy - () Sad
- Up - () Down

Day 26: Math - Before, After, and Between Numbers (up to 50)

- Write the number that comes before and after:
 - ____ 25 ____
 - ____ 40 ____
- Write the number that comes between:
 - 10 ____ 12
 - 35 ____ 37

Day 27: Hindi - वचन (Number - Singular/Plural) - एकवचन/बहुवचन

- Write the बहुवचन (plural) for these words:
 - लड़का (boy) - ____
 - पुस्तक (book) - ____

Day 28: EVS - Good Habits for Health

- List Five good habits that help you stay healthy with picture in Scrap book.

Day 29: Computer - Drawing with Shapes

- Use a simple drawing program to draw a picture using basic shapes like circles, squares, and triangles.

Day 30: Craft - Making a Paper Bag Puppet

- Use a small paper bag, paper scraps, and glue to create a puppet of an animal or a character in Scrapbook.

- Read storybooks in English and Hindi.
- Help with simple gardening tasks.
- Play board games with your family.
- Write a thank-you note to someone.
- Learn a new rhyme or song in either language.
