

# Summer Fun Learning - 30 Day Plan for Class 1

## Instructions for Parents/Guardians:

- This is a flexible 30-day plan. Feel free to adjust the activities based on your child's interests and pace.
- Encourage your child to complete one or two activities each day.
- Provide gentle guidance and support.
- Celebrate their efforts!

## Day 1: English - Alphabet Fun

- Write the small letters (a-z) in your notebook.
- Draw a picture of something that starts with the letter 'A'.

## Day 2: Math - Counting Objects

- Count all the spoons in your kitchen and write the number.
- Draw a group of 7 stars.

## Day 3: Hindi - Vowels (स्वर)

- Write the Hindi vowels (अ, आ, इ, ई, उ, ऊ, ऋ, ए, ऐ, ओ, औ) in your notebook.
- Say each vowel aloud.

## Day 4: EVS - My Body

- Draw/Paste a picture of yourself and label three parts of your body (e.g., head, eyes, and nose) in your scrap-book.

## Day 5: Computer - Introduction

- With a grown-up, point to the different parts of a computer (monitor, keyboard, mouse).
- Draw a simple picture of a computer screen.

## Day 6: Craft - Paper Folding

- Learn to make a simple paper fan with help from a grown-up.

## Day 7: English - Sight Words

- Learn to read and write these sight words: *the*, *a*, *is*.
- Use each word in a simple sentence (with help).

### **Day 8: Math - Number Recognition (1-10)**

- Look at numbers 1 to 10 in a book or on flashcards and say them aloud.
- Write the numbers 1 to 20 in your notebook.

### **Day 9: Hindi - Consonants (व्यंजन) - Part 1 (क to ङ)**

- Write the first five Hindi consonants (क, ख, ग, घ, ङ) and English such as K, kh ....in your notebook.
- Say each consonant aloud.

### **Day 10: EVS - My Family**

- Paste a picture of your family in Scrap book.
- Name the members of your family.

### **Day 11: Computer - Mouse Basics**

- With a grown-up, practice holding and moving the computer mouse.

### **Day 12: Craft - Finger Painting**

- Make a picture using your fingers and different colors of paint (on a safe surface with supervision) and paste in Scrapbook.

### **Day 13: English - Matching Capitals and Small Letters**

- Match the capital letters with their small letters [Aa to Zz] alphabet : like below
- A - ( ) a
- B - ( ) b
- C - ( ) c

### **Day 14: Math - Comparing Sizes**

- Draw big all shape and a small all shape.
- Write a table in note book from 2 to 10 (with help grown-up)

### **Day 15: Hindi - Consonants (व्यंजन) - Part 2 (च to ञ)**

- Write the next five Hindi consonants (च, छ, ज, झ, ञ) and English ch, chh ..... in your notebook.
- Say each consonant aloud.

### **Day 16: EVS - My School**

- Draw/Paste in scrap book a picture of our body part and learn all body parts name page no. 8
- Why should you eat healthy food? Name four healthy food name.

### **Day 17: Computer - Keyboard Basics**

- With a grown-up, point to the letter keys on the keyboard. Try to find the first letter of your name.

### **Day 18: Craft - Making Shapes with Clay/Play dough**

- Use clay or play dough to make a circle, a square, and a triangle.

### **Day 19: English - Picture Reading**

- Look at a simple picture in a storybook and tell a grown-up what you see.

### **Day 20: Math - Counting Backwards (100-1)**

- Practice counting backwards from 100 to 1 aloud.
- Write the numbers 50 to 1 in your notebook.

### **Day 21: Hindi - Consonants (व्यंजन) - Part 3 (ट to ण)**

- Write the next five Hindi consonants (ट, ठ, ड, ढ, ण) and English T, Th in your notebook.
- Say each consonant aloud.

### **Day 22: EVS - Animals around Us**

- Paste in your Scrap book 10 animals you have seen. And learn all.
- Draw your favorite animal.

### **Day 23: Computer - Identifying Icons**

- With a grown-up, look at some simple icons on a computer screen (like a recycle bin or a folder). Try to describe what they look like.

### **Day 24: Craft - Collage Making**

- Collect small pieces of paper, leaves, or fabric and glue them onto a sheet of paper to make a picture. All activities in Scrap book.

### **Day 25: English - Writing Simple Words**

- Practice writing Five-Five words from rhyming words: *at, en, in,*
- Write a 5-5 line in your Mothers and Fathers.

### **Day 26: Math - Addition with Pictures**

- Solve these simple addition problems and subtraction from your note book:
- Ordinal Numbers: Ordinal numbers tell us about order or position page no. 35.

### **Day 27: Hindi - Consonants (व्यंजन) - Part 4 (त to न)**

- Write the next five Hindi consonants (त, थ, द, ध, न) and English T, th, in your notebook.
- Paste a picture your grandfather/grandmother in scrapbook and write few word with help of Elder.

### **Day 28: EVS - Plants around Us**

- Name 10 types of Vegetable you have seen (e.g., cabbage, onion...).
- Draw a simple flower and paste in Scrap book.

### **Day 29: Computer - Turning On/Off (with supervision)**

- With a grown-up's help, learn how to safely turn a computer on and off.

### **Day 30: Craft - Nature Art**

- Collect small natural items like leaves, twigs, and pebbles. Arrange them on paper to create a picture and glue them down.

### **Bonus Activities (Do anytime you like!):**

- **Read a storybook in English or Hindi.**
- **Help a grown-up with simple tasks around the house.**
- **Play outdoor games.**
- **Draw and color your favorite cartoon character.**
- **Sing rhymes in English or Hindi.**
