Day 1: English - Common and Proper Nouns:

- List five common nouns you see around your house.
- List five proper nouns (names of people, places, or specific things) you know.

Day 2: Math - Place Value (Hundreds, Tens, Ones)

- Write the place value of each digit in the number 3512.
- Write three 3-digit numbers and draw beads on an abacus to represent them (you can draw the abacus).

- Learn to make a simple origami shape like a boat or a bird with the help of a tutorial or a grown-up.

Day 7: English – Pronouns:

- Replace the underlined nouns in the following sentences with suitable pronouns:

Day 8: Math - Addition and Subtraction (with carrying/borrowing)

- Solve these problems:

- Create a collage using different materials like paper, fabric scraps, buttons, and yarn on a sheet of paper.

Day 13: English - Adjectives - Degrees of Comparison:

- Write the comparative and superlative forms of these adjectives:
 - big
 - tall
 - small

Day 14: Math - Multiplication (Tables of 12, 13, 14, 15)

- Write down the multiplication tables of 12 and 13.
- Solve these: $24 \times 6 = ?$ $59 \times 8 = ?$

Day 17: Computer - Basic Operations on Files and Folders:

- With adult supervision, learn how to create a new folder on the computer.
- Write the steps you followed.

Day 18: Craft - Making Puppets (Sock Puppet or Paper Bag Puppet)

- Create a puppet using an old sock or a paper bag. Decorate it with yarn, buttons, and felt.

Day 19: English - Articles (a, an, the):

- Fill in the blanks with the correct article:

Day 20: Math - Division as Equal Sharing:

- Solve these division problems by drawing groups:
 - $120 \div 3 = ?$ (Share 120 items equally among 3 groups)

Day 25: English – Prepositions:

- Fill in the blanks with suitable prepositions (on, in, under, near):

Day 26: Math - Measurement - Length (using centimeters and meters)

- Measure the length of your notebook and your bed using a ruler or measuring tape (with help). Write down the measurements.
